How Your Business can Participate

step one

Organize an event: Share this guide with your boss or the head of human resources. Ask him or her to consider hosting a *Take Your Dog To Work Day* event on Friday, June 20, 2008. Before you start planning, ask fellow co-workers if there is anyone with serious objections or concerns. For example, you may have co-workers who suffer from severe pet allergies or who are afraid of dogs. If this is the case, don't give up. Instead, consider celebrating by having employees bring pictures of their canine companions or better yet, ask your company to host a fundraiser for an animal shelter in your community.

Step Two

Partner with a shelter. Ask your local shelter or favorite rescue group to join your *TYDTWDay* event. Invite them to bring adoptable pets or information about local adoption opportunities to your place of business. Consider holding a fundraiser to benefit the guest shelter.

Step Three

Ask a professional pet sitter to help. *TYDTWDay* is the perfect opportunity to educate employees about pet adoptions, responsible pet ownership and the benefits of hiring a professional pet sitter. Many PSI members are willing to volunteer some of their time to help coordinate your *TYDTWDay* event. Use PSI's Pet Sitter Locator (www.petsit.com) to find a participating PSI member in your area.

Step Four

Spread the word. Be sure to tell others in your community about this uniquely positive awareness campaign for dogs. The *Take Your Dog To Work Day* Web site (takeyourdog. com) has a free e-mail feature that allows you to tell others in or outside of the office about the day.

Step Five

Register at takeyourdog.com. Every year, PSI receives hundreds of phone calls from journalists and reporters looking to cover *TYDTWDay* stories.
